FIRE/LIFE SAFETY INSPECTION CHECK LIST

- 1. Emergency lighting must be operational and providing the required 1 ft candle avg.
- 2. Exit lights must be operational, and their placement provides proper visibility.
- 3. No storage may be placed in or under the exit stairwell.
- 4. No storage or other items (furniture, equipment) may be blocking exit doors and exit egress.
- 5. No exit doors may be locked or blocked while the business is occupied.
- 6. Fire alarms must have an up to date certification tag. Manual pull stations may not be blocked.
- 7. Fire extinguishers must have an up-to-date certification tag and be mounted on the wall.
- 8. Sprinkler protection devices require up-to-date certification tags. No storage allowed within 18" of a sprinkler head. Ceiling tiles must be in place and damaged tiles must be replaced. Backflow preventers require up-to-date certification tags.
- 9. No storage allowed in meter/electrical rooms. A "No Storage" sign must be posted in the meter room.
- 10. All commercial cooking equipment must be protected by a suppression hood system that is clean of grease (including filters). Fusible link(s) must be replaced and the certification tag must be up-to-date.
- 11. Remove all electrical extension cords being used as permanent wiring.
- 12. Post your Business Tax Receipt in plain view.
- 13. Have on site all paperwork available for all fire protection systems.
- 14. All construction supplies, equipment and debris have been removed from the site.
- 15. All fuel tanks to be posted with signs indicating type of fuel and capacity of tank.
- 16. Supra Max access box to be mounted 6 feet off the finished floor and in the at elevator lobby nearest the lowest level of fire department access.
- 17. Verify fire service elevator keys are present, operate elevator recall and elevator car.
- 18. Verify corridor rating, are there any penetrations, if so, is the material used to seal the same rating and listed.
- 19. Check doors for closing/latching along with the ratings, i.e. hardware, jamb, etc.

- 20. Verify all rated partitions being penetrated are supplied with fire/smoke dampers, as required.
- 21. Check flame spread for all interior finishes. Check for Certification and perform Field Flame Test.
- 22. Check handrail, guards and uniformity of steps. No more than 3/16 " variation.
- 23. Ensure all exit access, exit and exit discharge are not being compromised and in compliance along with required hardware.
- 24. Ensure common path, travel distance comply with NFPA 101 chap 7.
- 25. Verify that all ceiling heights and headroom (exit stairs) comply with approved signed & sealed plans.
- 26. Verify that roof access stairs comply with handrail requirements.
- 27. Check Handrails 34" to 36" with 12" extensions (return to wall or onto itself).
- 28. Check Handrail distance from wall 1-1/2" handrail circular cross section or comply with NFPA 101 chap 7.
- 29. Exit enclosures Check 1-hr rated walls: up to 3 floors with "b" label 1-hour doors w/closer.
- 30. Exit enclosures Check 2-hr rated walls: from 4 floors and up with "b" label 90 min w/closer.
- 31. Check all fire rated doors, must self-close & latch @ 45 degrees.
- 32. Confirm that trash chute door shall close & latches and has proper label.
- 33. Verify that smoke proof corridor doors are smoke tight.
- 34. All fire rated walls need to have proper fire stopping at all penetrations.
- 35. Check fire rated ceiling box around light fixtures in rated ceilings.
- 36. All power operated door locks need to be fail safe.
- 37. Confirm that Horizontal slider doors (where permitted) shall have breakaway feature
- 38. Exit signs shall be 6'-8" or higher but not more than 80" above egress door.
- 39. Exit access through the roof shall have protective guards at 42" all the way to the exit.
- 40. Exit stairs shall have a minimum headroom of 6'-8"
- 41. Doors from mechanical/non-occupied rooms shall not open directly into exit enclosures.
- 42. Egress doors shall have level floors on both sides, and a maximum threshold height of ½".
- 43. Ensure that Means of Egress is not through kitchens or other hazardous areas.
- 44. Verify that all exits are clearly marked.
- 45. Confirm that apartment doors in stairwells have the same rating as the stairwell.
- 46. Stairwells shall be free of any wiring, conduits or anything other than those related to that stairwell.

- 47. Changes in elevations along a means of egress shall be provided with the required handrails.
- 48. Egress paths: minimum 44" wide= > than 50 occupants and 36" wide= < than 50 occupants.
- 49. Doors swinging into an egress path do not restrict more than 1/2 of the required width. Final door position to be equal or less than 7 inches into clear width.
- 50. Confirm that there are no hangings or draperies placed over exit doors or located so that they obstruct or conceal an exit.
- 51. Verify 6" building address numbers on address side of building.
- 52. Verify Knox-box entry system is installed near front entrance of addressable side of the building and has labeled keys and access cards.
